

Unit 3 Exam Preparation and Review Sheet - This is a totally closed note exam. Any documents used on the exam will be provided.

1. The exam will ask you to list and the six factors leading to the Great Depression we discussed in class. You will then be asked to explain which factor you think was most important bringing about the depression. **How to study: Memorize the six factors by thinking about how each one led to the Great Depression. Understanding how each factor led to the Depression will help you remember them.**

2. The exam will include several advertisements from the 1920s. You will be asked to explain how the ads manipulate consumers using the five tools of modern advertising that we discussed in class. **How to study: Memorize the five tools and then practice explaining how they are used using the ads available on the website.**

3. The exam will ask you to compare the approach taken by Hoover and FDR to fight the great depression. **How to study: Review your notes on Hoover and FDR. Pay particular attention to each man's philosophy and how this philosophy was demonstrated in the laws and policies that they supported. Memorize at least one specific law/policy that you can use to illustrate each president's philosophy. Be prepared to explain why the policies either succeeded or failed.**

4. The exam will ask you to interpret several of the graphs that dealt with inequality. You will be asked to answer questions based on the data and to support your answers with specific data from the appropriate graphs. **How to study: Look over the graphs used in class. Make sure you understand what each graph is about, what time period it describes and what it says about inequality. Practice by identifying what the graph says about inequality and identifying a specific fact from the graph that supports this claim. No memorization is necessary here.**

5. The exam will ask you to explain the economic policy of Andrew Mellon. Then you will be asked if this policy succeeded or failed and to provide evidence to support this claim. **How to study: Memorize who Mellon was and what his policies did. Be able to provide an example of these policies. Be prepared to explain one way his policy succeeded and one way it failed based on information from your notes and the graphs.**

6. The exam will ask you to examine several different types of evidence regarding the Great Depression. You will then be asked to use the evidence provided to make an argument about the effects of the Great Depression. This argument will be made in a BMP and must be supported by examples from the evidence provided on the exam. **How to study: Review the structure of a BMP. Practice making arguments about the effects of the Depression and supporting these arguments with evidence taken from the effects of the Great Depression activity.**
