<p>A. Good will is good not because of what it performs or effects, not by its aptness for the attainment of some proposed end, but simply by virtue of the volition; that is, it is good in itself.</p>	
<p>B. Thus the moral worth of an action does not lie in the effect expected from it, . . . The pre-eminent good which we call moral can therefore consist in nothing else than the conception of law in itself, which certainly is only possible in a rational being, in so far as this conception, and not the expected effect, determines the will. This is a good which is already present in the person who acts accordingly, and we have not to wait for it to appear first in the result.</p>	
<p>C. (Ethical) Duty is the necessity of acting from respect for the (moral) law [which is defined by reason and takes the following two forms called categorical imperatives:]</p>	
<p>D. [version one of the categorical imperative] I am never to act otherwise than so that I could also will that my maxim should become a universal law.</p>	
<p>E. [version two of the categorical imperative] Man and generally any rational being exists as an end in himself, not merely as a means to be arbitrarily used by this or that will, but in all his actions, whether they concern himself or other rational beings, must be always regarded at the same time as an end . . . So act as to treat humanity, whether in thine own person or in that of any other, in every case as an end withal, never as means only.</p>
