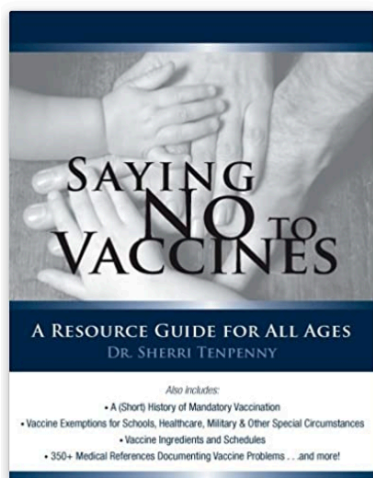


Investigate the Source Activity
