

For each of the documents listed below, answer as many questions as you can. How the Jews are characterized (what are they like?) What does the document indicates the goals of the Jews are? What does the document say (or imply) should be done to deal with the Jews? This should be done in your own words.

A. But the most potent action any awakened person can take is this: to erect again our own moral landmarks, which the Oriental Jewish invasion has broken down. This would spell sheer doom to the whole evil system sponsored by the Jews. And this is the course which has never been tried.
